Stark State College – Nursing School | Akron, Ohio*

Stark State utilized the unfinished third floor of their recently completed Akron building to house their nursing program. The space consisted of labs, classrooms, collaborative areas, and a simulation lab. Coordination was done between faculty and lab specialists to ensure the specific needs were met for this program. Finishes on this floor differed from the rest of the building to create a calming environment for the users.

Streetsboro Middle School | Streetsboro, Ohio*

After building a new high school Streetsboro City Schools renovated the old building to create a new space for the middle school. 21st Century design concepts were considered when creating the floor plan by designated areas for alternate learning and collaboration. Furniture pieces were selected to cater to the non-traditional classroom offering flexible options to students throughout the day. Lively colors were used throughout to engage students and create a playful environment.

Seville Animal Hospital | Seville, Ohio*

A renovation and addition project to the existing Seville Animal Hospital. After the addition was built on to the existing building the staff was relocated to the new part of the building while the existing was renovated. With this being a more complicated phased project, coordination between all parties was key. The treatment areas are bright with lighter finishes and earthy accents in the reception and exam areas.

The Still House | Canton, Ohio*

Inspired by Spanish cathedral design The Still House was created to introduce distillery production at Gervasi Vineyards. This building included a large production area, tasting room, and guest services for the lodging located on the grounds. A storefront window system was used behind the tasting room bar connecting guests to the production process. Eclectic elements, like confessional booths and Spanish style finishes, were included in the design to achieve a themed environment creating an experience for each person that comes in.
