After working closely with the facilities department, GDOT was able to accommodate the furniture needs for both the Cleveland & Cambridge locations. The Cleveland Office expansion focused on integrating relocated employees while maximizing space & functionality. The workspace now allows over 100 employees to operate more efficiently. The rejuvenation of the Cambridge Service Office included 37 new workstations and ancillary furniture. Both locations were furnished using Teknion's leverage panel system, lounge furniture and storage.
