### Menlo Park Academy | Cleveland, Ohio

A 4-Story, 81,312 SF historic redevelopment that involved State and Federal Tax Credits. This project had a condensed schedule, significant budget constraints, and was a challenging historic building. We created a modern concept charter school, within this once occupied clothing factory. Project consisted of an open concept design to accommodate a changing environment in an educational setting, with large efforts to preserve the building's roots.

### Tarkett | Solon, Ohio

Tarkett is a worldwide leader of innovative and sustainable flooring and sport surface solutions. The goal was to renovate the interior and exterior of an existing 148,643 SF four-story office building to establish a new permanent U.S. Headquarters with a design showroom. The exterior was updated to create a new local iconic landmark building, while the interior build-out created cutting edge office and showroom spaces.

### Firefighters Community Credit Union | Cuyahoga Heights, Ohio

With several other branches locally, Firefighters strived to incorporate a developing "prototype" into their newest facility in Cuyahoga Heights. The 15,000 SF building features a brick "Western Reserve" exterior and a more modern interior color palette and furniture selection.

### Tim Lally Chevrolet | Warrensville Heights, Ohio

The Tim Lally dealership is a new 71,006 SF showroom and service facility reflecting the latest Chevrolet building design vision. The facility features a state of the art 19,200 SF showroom with a theater room for entertaining customers while their vehicles are serviced in the new 51,806 SF Service and Collision Center.

### Great Gatherings | Fairfax, Virginia

A 15,663 SF retail interior fit-out and new storefront system constructed at street level of the mosaic shopping district. The interior and exterior work were designed in collaboration with the owner, landlord, and local jurisdictions with the intent to reflect Great Gatherings vision for a clean, contemporary and inviting retail space.
